

Step—by—step covering guide for paperback and hardcover books using **Non Adhesive Film**

You can use Clear Gloss, Orange Peel or Polypropylene Film as covering material.
You also require scissors, squeegee, attaching tape, clips.



STEP 1. Pull film from roll, lay book face up on it leaving about 50mm on the top, right edge, and bottom. Turn the book and film to the left (same as picture). Cut film from the roll.

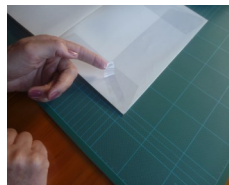
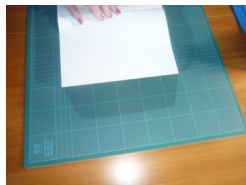
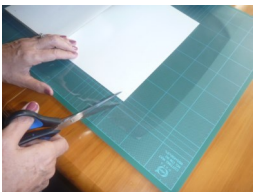


STEP 2. Fold front flap in, crease, and clamp with clip. Repeat for the back flap. Cut narrow 'V' into either side of the spine, both top and bottom.

You can now do **EITHER** step 3 **OR** step 4



STEP 3. Fold front bottom and top flaps in and crease. Tape. Repeat for the back.



STEP 4. Cut front bottom and top corners as shown. Fold front flap in followed by the top and bottom and crease. Tape the joint. Repeat



STEP 5. Trim the tab from the spine, top and bottom.
Your covering is now finished.
